



First Aid Erase Restore

To use First Aid, select the volume and click a repair button.

- You can verify or repair any volume format supported by Mac OS X.
- First Aid cannot repair a write-protected disk, a CD-ROM, or a disk with open repair or verify the startup disk, boot from the Mac OS X Install CD and select Disk Utility from the Installer Menu.
- You may only repair permissions on a volume with Mac OS X installed.
- If Disk Utility cannot make repairs, try other disk repair programs or back up your data and erase the volume.
